POLICE CONTROL

Schedule 7 of the Terrorism Act 2000 provides that:

An examining officer may question a person whom he believes is entering or leaving Great Britain, or Northern Ireland, or is travelling by air within Great Britain, for the purpose of determining whether that person is or has been concerned in the commission, preparation or instigation of acts of terrorism.

He may for the same purpose question a person on a ship or aircraft which has arrived at any place in Great Britain or Northern Ireland (whether from within or outside Great Britain or Northern Ireland).

(para 2)

Any person who is questioned under this power must:

- (a) give the examining officer any information in his possession which the officer requests,
- (b) give the officer on request either a valid passport which includes a photograph or another document which establishes his identity,
- (c) disclose whether he has with him any documents of a kind specified by the examining officer,
- (d) give the examining officer on request any document which he has with him which is specified by the officer.

(para 5)

A person commits an offence if he:

- (a) wilfully fails to comply with a duty imposed under or by virtue of this Schedule,
- (b) wilfully contravenes a prohibition imposed under or by virtue of this Schedule, or
- (c) wilfully obstructs, or seeks to frustrate, a search or examination under or by virtue of this Schedule.
